Information concerning the processing of your personal data

Care and transparency are the basis for a trusting cooperation with our customers, service providers and suppliers. We therefore inform you about how we process your data and how you can exercise the rights to which you are entitled under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Which personal data we process and for what purpose depends on the respective contractual relationship.

3 Which of your personal data is used by us?

If you have an inquiry, have us prepare an offer or conclude a contract with us, we process your personal data. In addition, we process your personal data to fulfil legal obligations, to safeguard a legitimate interest or on the basis of your consent.

Depending on the legal basis, the following categories of personal data are involved:

- name, first name
- adress
- communication data (phone, e-mail-address)
- bank information (name of the bank and location, account number, account holder; if necessary for international payments: IBAN and SWIFT/BIC)

In the course of initiating the contract, we also make use of data provided to us by third parties. Depending on the type of contract, the following categories of personal data are involved:

- Confirmation of your bank information by the account-holding bank

4 For what purposes do we process your data and on what legal basis?

We process your personal data in particular in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) as well as all other relevant laws.

On the initiation and performance of a contract (Art. 6 para. 1 b GDPR)

As part of the contract initiation process, we process your data to prepare an offer for our goods and services and in the event of a contract to fulfill the contract.

In addition, we use your personal data within the framework of the contract on electronic payment transactions to initiate electronic credit notes for the purchase of goods and/or services by electronic transfer (EFT)/wire to our bank account.

Issue of consent (Art. 6 para. 1 a GDPR) and legitimate interests (Art. 6 para f. GDPR)

On the basis of your consent and our legitimate interests, we will use your personal data for product information about our offer, which we will communicate to you by e-mail or telephone (see below 10.).

5 To whom will your data be shared?

In order to fulfil our contractual and legal obligations, your personal data will be disclosed to various public or internal bodies as well as external service providers.

6 Is your data transferred to countries outside the European Union (so-called third countries)?

Countries outside the European Union (and the European Economic Area "EEA") handle the protection of personal data differently than countries within the European Union. We also use service providers located in third countries outside the European Union to process your data. There is currently no decision by the EU Commission that these third countries generally offer an adequate level of protection.

We have therefore taken special measures to ensure that your data is processed in third countries as securely as within the European Union. We conclude the standard data protection

clauses provided by the Commission of the European Union with service providers in third countries. These clauses provide appropriate safeguards for the protection of your data by third country service providers.

7 How long is my data being saved?

We store your personal data as long as it is necessary to fulfil our legal and contractual obligations.

If storage of the data is no longer necessary for the fulfilment of contractual or legal obligations, your data will be deleted unless further processing is necessary for the following purposes:

- Fulfilment of commercial and tax retention obligations. Storage periods from the Commercial Code (HGB) or the Fiscal Code (AO) are to be mentioned: 6 years.
- Preservation of evidence within the framework of the statutory statute of limitations. According to the statute of limitations provisions of the German Civil Code (BGB), in some cases these statutes of limitations can be up to 30 years, the regular statute of limitations is three years.

8 What rights do you have in regard to the processing of your data?

Every data subject has the right to information pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR, the right to rectification pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR, the right to cancellation pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR, the right to limitation of processing pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR, the right to opposition pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR and the right to data transfer pursuant to Art. 20 GDPR. The restrictions under §§ 34 and 35 BDSG apply to the right to information and the right to cancellation.

a. Right of objection

You can object to the use of your data for advertising purposes using electronic mail at any time without incurring any costs other than the transmission costs according to the basic tariffs.

b. Revocation of consent

You can revoke your consent to the processing of personal data at any time. Please note that the revocation is only effective for the future.

c. Right to access information

You may request information as to whether we have stored personal data about you. We will let you know, if you wish, what the data is, for what purposes it will be processed, to whom it will be disclosed, for how long it will be stored and what other rights you have in relation to it.

d. Other rights

In addition, you have the right to correct false data or to delete your data. If there is no reason for further storage, we will delete your data, otherwise we will restrict processing. You may also request that we provide any personal information you have provided to us in a structured, common and machine-readable format either to you or to a person or company of your choice.

In addition, you have the right to appeal to the competent data protection supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR in conjunction with § 19 BDSG).
